Each part of this comprehensive resource has been developed to maximise its use by being specifically cross curricular. Whilst utilising the literacy route for delivery (for scenarios, worksheets and all material on the DVD) it is heavily biased towards PSHE and Citizenship, in order to cover all aspects of the personal, social and health and wellbeing of the pupil, including road safety. However the chart below gives an overview of how the 26 scenarios, the suggested extension activities for each, plus the 416 worksheets all closely link into each of the curriculum areas for English/PSHE & Citizenship/Maths/Science/History/Geography/ICT/Art and Design.
